- 2. Applicant must express a desire to attend an art school, college, or university with a focus on art. The term "art" shall mean graphic arts, fine arts and crafts, performance arts, music, literature, photography, or film.
- 3. This scholarship shall be awarded on the basis of merit and not solely on financial need.
- 4. A candidate who has once received an award under this scholarship shall thereafter be eligible as a candidate for further awards, until such time as the Selection Committee determines that the candidate has completed his/her academic program or has ceased to make reasonable progress toward such completion or has ceased to be regularly enrolled at the art school, college or university.
- 5. A portfolio of the candidate's artwork must be submitted with the application.
- 6. If selected as a finalist, an interview with the Selection Committee is required.
