Criteria for Award Scholarship

1. Applicant must be a graduate, or graduating senior, of a high school in Trinity County, California.
2. Applicant must express a desire to attend an art school, college, or university with a focus on art. The term “art” shall mean graphic arts, fine arts and crafts, performance arts, music, literature, photography, or film.
3. This scholarship shall be awarded on the basis of merit and not solely on financial need.
4. A candidate who has once received an award under this scholarship shall thereafter be eligible as a candidate for further awards, until such time as the Selection Committee determines that the candidate has completed his/her academic program or has ceased to make reasonable progress toward such completion or has ceased to be regularly enrolled at the art school, college or university.
5. A portfolio of the candidate’s artwork must be submitted with the application.
6. If selected as a finalist, an interview with the Selection Committee is required.
